Responsibilities	<p>Task force members will:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Consult with their individual school councils, and other school council parents if and when available, and provide information and views to the Board of Directors when requested. 2. Advise the Board of Directors on any new or emerging advocacy issues. 3. Be willing to be contacted to attend forums, meetings or other events held by Alberta Education or education stakeholder organizations.
Composition & Term of Service	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Task force members will be parents serving on ASCA member school councils and identified as liaison by their school council. 2. Task force members will serve for the 2017-2018 school year. 3. Board members are ineligible to be their school council representative on the School Council Engagement Task Force.
Reporting Requirements	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The Board of Directors will report the activities stemming from or related to the Task Force to all members at the Annual General Meeting of the Association.
