

Request for input for **Alberta Education Business Planning**

The Government of Alberta develops three-year strategic plans with the provincial budget delivery.

Each Ministry also creates their own business plan aligning with the strategic direction of the government.

Plans are updated annually as part of the budget process.

Alberta Education identified priorities in the [2018-2021 business plan](#), and is now seeking input from stakeholder groups to inform their planning and priorities for the (next) 2019-2022 business plan.

Alberta Education wants to hear from parents on school councils to gather information and perspective to foster better insights and make education better “together”.
