Resources on new.LearnAlberta.ca

Alberta Education remains committed to helping French immersion teachers prepare to pilot, implement, and successfully deliver new Kindergarten to Grade 12 (K-12) curriculum through the provision of learning and teaching resources on [new.LearnAlberta.ca](https://new.learnalberta.ca). Many of these learning and teaching resources are also available to parents, students, and the public.

Authorization of French immersion learning and teaching resources to support the piloting and implementation of new K-6 curriculum is a priority for Alberta Education. New French learning and teaching resources are being added to new.LearnAlberta.ca on an ongoing basis. Increased access to learning and teaching resources for French immersion teachers will continue throughout the 2024/25 school year to support full implementation of Science and French Immersion Language Arts and Literature, as well as piloting of draft Social Studies.

How to access resources

Alberta Education has curated a collection of learning and teaching resources on new.LearnAlberta.ca for French immersion teachers. There are three sections on new.LearnAlberta.ca that can support French immersion teachers to pilot and implement new K-6 curriculum:

- [Explore resources](#): provides a variety of learning and teaching resources that align to learning outcomes;
- [Alberta's K-6 curriculum](#): allows teachers to click on the information button on the top right side of the learning outcome, and then on "Resources" to see a list of all resources aligned to that learning outcome; and
- [Boards](#): a tool available only for Alberta's teachers to create and share resources across the province in a closed environment.
 - Boards may also be created by stakeholders, such as the Alberta Professional Learning Consortium.

Implementation of new K-6 curriculum

As of July 2024, there are over 1,000 learning and teaching resources on new.LearnAlberta.ca to support implementation of new K-6 curriculum in French immersion programs.

Implementation of new K-6 curriculum

Alberta Education works with a variety of stakeholders to procure learning and teaching resources to support the piloting and implementation of new K-12 curriculum. Alberta Education is currently working with a variety of school authorities from across the province to support the development of learning and teaching resources. Some of these initiatives include the following:

- K-3 Science (anticipated to be shared on new.LearnAlberta.ca prior to fall 2024/25);
- Grades 4-6 Science (anticipated to be shared on new.LearnAlberta.ca prior to fall 2025/26); and
- K-6 Social Studies (anticipated to be shared on new.LearnAlberta.ca prior to fall 2025/26).
